I promised I would send in a testimonial about my interactions with your company. You can use all or any part of it.

Several years ago my son bought some property that had a small animal pond on it. It is 2/3 of an acre. We wanted to convert this animal pond into a fishing pond. The previous owner had stocked it with some catfish and a few other types of fish. The pond was very muddy due to the animal (horses) activity. We added additional fish (catfish) only because the pond was muddy and we didn't think any other species would survive. We eventually change our minds and wanted to see if we could stock bass and panfish. We knew we had to do something about the water clarity. We tried chemicals (aluminum sulphate) twice (\$100 each) to clean up the pond. One only lasted a few weeks, the other cause a fish kill. The year before last, I thought it may be the catfish, so I fished them out the best I could. I caught over 100! That helped but not enough. Last year I installed a windmill and it help quite a bit but I still wanted it clearer. I did research on the web and found CLEAN-FLO.
