"As an avid birder in the Fort Collins area, I can attest to the success that local residents at Warren Lake have had in making improvements that attract birds to the lake.

The last two winters in particular, thanks to the aeration system installed in the lake, Warren Lake has been a mecca for rare gulls. Birders from all over Colorado, and surrounding states as well, have visited the area to observe these rare species, including Great Black-backed Gull, Glaucous-winged Gull, Glaucous Gull, and numerous Lesser Black-backed Gulls, Iceland Gulls, and Herring Gulls.

In fact, Warren Lake was the venue for a field workshop on gull identification that I taught for the Denver Audubon Master Birder Class earlier this month. The local residents of the communities surrounding Warren Lake are eager to learn more about birds and other wildlife, and make further improvements.

I was invited by the Warren Lake community to speak on the birds of Warren Lake last week, and was shocked to find 60 people in attendance. This is a motivated and committed group."
